NETLEY CREEK “OPEN” FALL CLASSIC RULES

*Format will be a **texas scramble, best ball foursome game**. Where each team will play from the best shot until holed out. The two designated holes (#3 & #12) will only be counted and used to break a tie. A shot gun start will apply at 9:00 a.m. sharp so all players must head for their designated hole by 9:15-9:20 a.m. If some holes are doubled up then the **team** number with a “A” will start first, and “B” will tee off second. **Because of the number of golfers and time restrictions all players should also be playing ready golf.** That means your short distance hitters should always hit first or if you are equal players then whoever is ready can tee up first, and continue to play that way till teed out. If you are found falling behind or littering your team will be asked to take a 10 stroke penalty and move to the next hole.

RULES:

***For both the Front and Back nine holes each player MUST use at least TWO of their drives per each nine.** If you are a threesome your team can designate a player for the balance of each nine. ***For hole (#3) and (#12) EACH PLAYER MUST PLAY THEIR OWN BALL AND COUNT EACH OF THEIR OWN STROKES** until holed out. **These holes are prize holes and will be used as a tie breaker hole. NOTE: All drives MUST be played from your own fairway,** all other balls that land in the wrong fairway are considered OUT OF BOUNCE and can not be used as the longest drive or best ball. This rule allows for a more equal opportunity for both beginner and advance players since no handicaps are used. ***FOR OUR \$25,000 PURSE ON HOLE #3 - FIRST ONE TO GET IT IN THE HOLE WILL WIN THE \$25,000 CASH PRIZE – ONLY ONE PRIZE AVAILABLE. If no one gets a hole-in-one on the first try then one Mulligan may be used by each player for a second chance to win a 10 Game Golf Pass.**

***All prizes must be excepted as is, golf course has final say on all rulings. Thank You**

Volunteer Spotter’s, Marshals and Beverage Cart persons will also be watching and keeping track of honest and fair play during this fun tournament, and will help answer any questions or rulings.

*There will also be volunteer spotters sitting at Hole #3, our **\$25,000 cash prize** to witness and take mulligan tickets.

MULLIGAN TICKETS: Only one ticket per person can be used for prize holes and must be given to the volunteer before hitting your next shot after each team player has had one shot. NOTE: Once you decide to use a Mulligan shot then player MUST use that shot and delete the first shot even if it was better than the second. (A mulligan is when you hit a bad shot and want to hit another with no penalty). Before using a Mulligan player MUST announce that he/she wishes to use a Mulligan and give a ticket to your designated team captain or appointed team player. A **maximum of (3) Three Mulligan’s per player** (but not more than one mulligan per hole, per player) may be used for entire round. **(Maximum of 10 per team)**

***ALL DIVOTS AND BALL MARKS MUST BE REPAIRED, PLUS SAND BUNKERS RAKED AND GARBAGE CANS USED OR YOUR TEAM WILL GET A TWO STROKE PENALTY.**
